RESOLUTION No. 2020-09

**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE MILLAGE RATE
FOR REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE
CITY OF CEDAR SPRINGS FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR 2020 – 2021.**

WHEREAS, Chapter VI. of the City Charter; General Finance, Taxation, Borrowing Powers: Section 6.3 Budget Hearing states: “A public hearing on the budget shall be held before its adoption, at such time and place as the Council shall direct, and notice of such public hearing shall be published at least one (1) week in advance by the Clerk. A copy of the proposed budget shall be on file and available to the public for inspection during office hours at the Office of the Clerk for period of not less than one (1) week prior to such public hearing,” and

WHEREAS, the public notice of a public hearing to be held on May 14, 2020 for the 2020 – 2021 budget for the City of Cedar Springs was published in The Cedar Springs Post; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2020 – 08 this City Council approved of the budget for fiscal year 2020 – 2021 and which was the subject of the public hearing held on May 14, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Chapter VI of the City Charter; General Finance, Taxation, Borrowing Powers: Section 6.4 Adoption of Budget, Tax Limit states: “Not later than the third (3) Monday of May, the Council shall, by resolution, adopt the budget for the next fiscal year and shall, in such resolution make an appropriation for the money needed for municipal purposes during the ensuing fiscal year of the City and provide for a levy of the amount necessary to be raised by taxes upon real and personal property for municipal purposes, which levy shall not exceed two (2) percent of the assessed valuation of all real and personal property subject to taxation in the City;” and

WHEREAS, the City Council in the City of Cedar Springs Budget for 2020-2021 (Resolution No. 2020-08) approved to raise the following Property Tax Revenue:

General Fund	\$1, 245, 190
Refuse and Disposal Fund	\$ 44, 410
Public Library	\$ 77, 900

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That, this City Council does hereby levy the following Millage Rate on all real and personal property subject to taxation within the City of Cedar Springs for the purpose of generating the required Property Tax amounts as set forth in the Financial Plan for Fiscal Year July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 for the City of Cedar Springs:
