**RE: Marihuana Retailer
Application Moratorium**

The City Council has imposed a moratorium on the acceptance, processing or approval of any more than 4 marihuana retailer applications in the combined B2-B3 zoning districts nor more than 3 marihuana retailer applications in the HC zoning district for the next six months, lasting through September 13th, 2021. This moratorium only affects Marihuana Retailers and does not affect Marihuana Microbusinesses, Growers, Processors or Safety Compliance Facilities. Those businesses are allowed to continue applying for marihuana licenses according to the City's current regulatory and zoning requirements.

At the time of this writing, 3 of the 4 B2-B3 and 2 of the 3 HC Marihuana Retailer Licenses have been locked up. No licenses will be held or reserved for any person or group and they remain on a first come first served basis to all parties.

Applicants must submit a full and complete marihuana application and have it accepted by City Hall to "lock up" one of the remaining licenses. If the applicant fails to finalize that application into a license, the City would then accept applications until such time that the permitted licenses are obtained. I strongly recommend that you speak with the City Manager before proceeding forward with any marihuana applications.

Prior to or following the six-month period ending on September 13th, 2021, the City may amend its ordinances to place new limitations on the number of permitted marihuana businesses allowed to operate in the City.
